WHAT IS DENTAL DISEASE?

Problems usually start with a build up of sticky plaque that hardens to form tartar. If not removed, this can lead to gingivitis, a painful condition of inflamed gums. And even worse, the bacteria and toxins present in the infected mouth can enter the bloodstream and affect vital organs, causing serious illnesses including heart and kidney disease.

It can be difficult to keep your pet's teeth clean, so dental problems are common. According to the American Veterinary Dental Society eight out of ten pets have oral disease by the age of four.





CAUSES

Factors that can make pets more prone to dental disease include:

Age

Dental disease is more common in older pets.

Breed

Small dogs are more likely to have overcrowded mouths and teeth are harder to keep clean.

Food

Feeding a diet containing sticky foods and titbits can lead to a more rapid build-up of plaque.

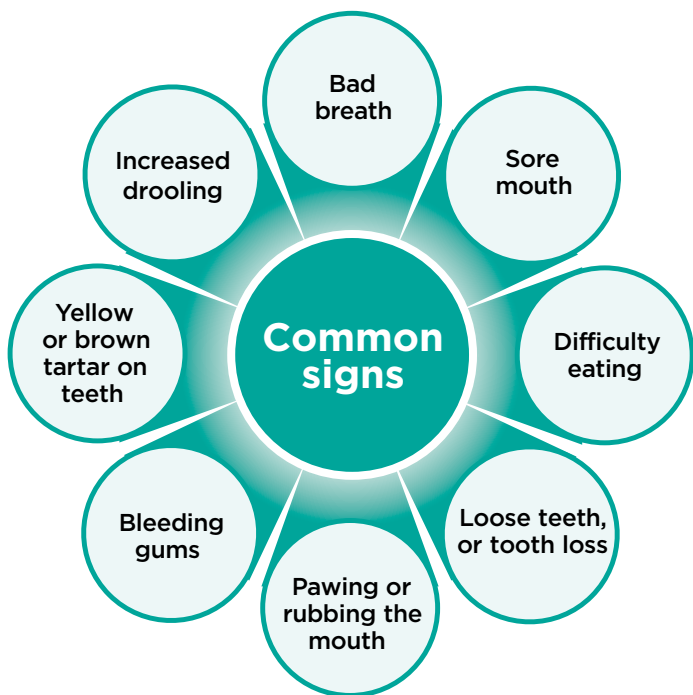
Damage

Accidents, bones or even hard plastic frisbees can damage teeth.

CAN FOOD HELP?

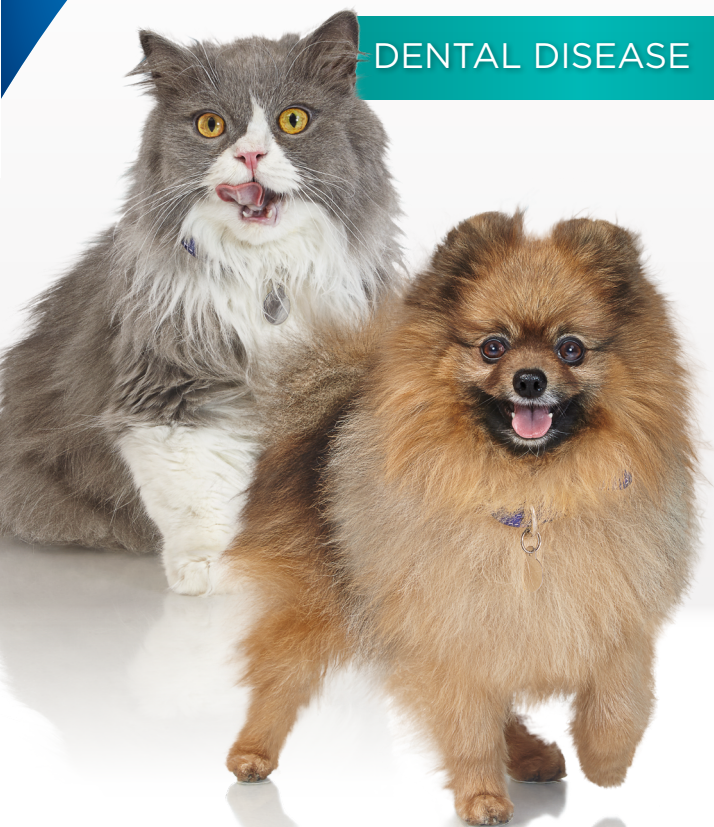

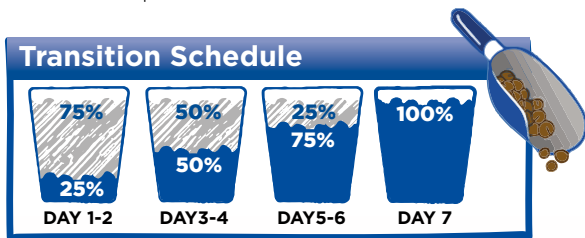
